PART 1

Your Quick-Start Guide to Affiliate Marketing

Welcome! If you're an author, book blogger, podcaster, or creator in the publishing space, you've already built something priceless: an audience that trusts your recommendations. Affiliate marketing is one of the most authentic and sustainable ways to monetize that trust — by earning a commission every time you recommend a product or service that genuinely helps your readers.

What is Affiliate Marketing?

In simple terms, affiliate marketing is a **performance-based partnership**. When you join a company's affiliate program, you receive a unique, trackable link. When someone clicks your link and makes a purchase, the company pays you a percentage of that sale as a thank-you for sending them a new customer. It is a genuine win-win-win: the customer discovers a great product, the company gains a sale, and you earn passive income.

Unlike sponsored posts or paid advertisements, affiliate marketing is entirely performance-based. You only earn when your recommendation actually leads to a sale. This aligns your incentives perfectly with your audience's interests: you are motivated to recommend only the best products, because those are the ones that convert.

FTC Disclosure Requirements

Trust is your most valuable asset as a creator. The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) in the United States — and equivalent bodies in other countries — requires you to clearly disclose your affiliate relationships. A simple, prominent statement is all that is needed:

"Please note: This post contains affiliate links. If you click through and make a purchase, I may earn a small commission at no additional cost to you. I only recommend products I genuinely use and believe in."

Place this disclosure at the top of any blog post, video description, or email that contains affiliate links. Transparency builds trust and protects you legally.

How to Get Started: A 4-Step Walkthrough

Step 1: Choose the Right Programs

The best programs are those whose products you genuinely use or that you know will solve a real problem for your specific audience. If your readers are aspiring self-published authors, a tool like Publisher Rocket or Vellum is a natural fit. If you serve book bloggers, Bookshop.org is an excellent choice. This guide gives you 26+ options across every corner of the publishing world.

Step 2: Sign Up for the Program

This guide sorts programs into three tiers based on ease of sign-up. **Tier 1 programs** have a simple form directly on their own website or a lightweight platform like Tolt or FirstPromoter — you can often be approved and generating links within minutes. **Tier 3 programs** require you to first create a free account on a major affiliate network such as Impact, CJ Affiliate, or ShareASale. Once your network profile is approved (usually within 1–3 business days), you can apply to individual company programs within that network.

Step 3: Get Your Unique Affiliate Links

Once approved, you will receive access to a dashboard where you can find your unique referral links. Many programs also provide pre-made banners, email copy, social media graphics, and other promotional materials. Take advantage of these — they are designed to convert.

Step 4: Share Your Links Authentically

This is the most important step. Do not simply drop links randomly into your content. Weave them into genuinely valuable material: a detailed software review, a step-by-step tutorial, a 'Resources I Use' page on your website, or a recommended tools section in your email newsletter. The more helpful and authentic your recommendation, the more likely your audience is to click and convert.

Best Practices for Long-Term Success

Promote Only What You Know and Trust	The most successful affiliates are passionate and knowledgeable about the products they recommend. Your audience can tell the difference between a genuine endorsement and a cash grab. Stick to tools and services you have personally used or thoroughly researched.
Focus on Value, Not Just Sales	Create high-quality content that helps your audience solve a real problem. The affiliate income is a byproduct of the value you provide. A comprehensive guide to formatting a self-published book — with an honest Vellum or Atticus recommendation woven in — will outperform a bare affiliate link every single time.
Diversify Your Programs	Do not rely on a single affiliate program for all your income. Commission rates change, programs close, and companies pivot. This guide gives you 26+ options. Aim to have active relationships with at least five to eight programs across different categories.
Track Your Performance	Use the dashboards provided by your affiliate programs to see what is working. Which links receive the most clicks? Which pieces of content drive the most sales? Use this data to double down on what converts and refine or retire what does not.
Build an Email List	Your email list is your most powerful affiliate marketing asset. Unlike social media algorithms, your list belongs to you. A well-timed email recommending a tool like MailerLite or Scrivener to a list of engaged authors can generate significant commissions from a single send. MailerLite itself has a 30% lifetime affiliate program — making it both a tool and a revenue stream.
Understand Cookie Durations	When someone clicks your affiliate link, a 'cookie' is placed in their browser that tracks the referral. If they purchase within the cookie window, you earn the commission. Cookie durations vary widely — from 24 hours (Amazon) to 30 days (most programs) to lifetime (Payhip). Prioritize programs with longer cookie windows when possible.

Every program below has been individually verified as of March 2026. All links go directly to the affiliate sign-up or information page. Programs are sorted into three tiers based on how easy they are to join — Tier 1 being the simplest. All links include UTM tracking parameters so you can measure traffic from this guide in your analytics dashboard.

TIER 1 — Direct & Simple Sign-Up (No Network Account Required)

These 16 programs use their own sign-up form, or a lightweight platform such as Tolt, FirstPromoter, or Airtable. Approval is typically instant or within 24 hours.

Lulu.com	Has an affiliate presence via Sovrn and Yeesshh ad networks but no clean direct sign-up page as of March 2026. Monitor their site for updates.
Jasper AI	Ended their affiliate program in January 2025. Replaced in this guide by Writesonic and Sudowrite, both of which offer comparable or better terms.
BookBub	Does not offer a traditional affiliate/referral commission program for external promoters. BookBub is a paid advertising platform for authors — not an affiliate program.
Amazon Associates	If you promote any book on Amazon, sign up for Amazon Associates (affiliate-program.amazon.com). You earn a small commission on the book sale itself, plus any other items the customer adds to their cart within 24 hours of clicking your link.
